DISTRICT COUNCIL & PARISH ELECTIONS

The election for the whole district council – 40 seats will take place on the 4th May. Parish and town council (which are the equivalent status as parishes) will take place the same day. Rapidly followed by the Coronation, count timing will be interesting.
